

Change of Status to Honorary Docent

You are eligible for a change of status after completing the 5-year commitment which you agreed to when you began the docent training program (see the Docent Program Handbook).

We are grateful for your many years of service to the MIA. Here is a summary of what happens when you become an Honorary Docent.

We invite you to participate in:

- MGP luncheons and parties
- Honorary Docent group activities

You will receive an MGP Continuing Education calendar, invitations to MGP special events, and a list of upcoming Honorary Docent activities.

You have been issued an Honorary Docent ID badge which is enclosed.

The following access is no longer available:

- Your electronic badge is turned in and deactivated. You are always welcome to use the Museum Guides Resource Center. Please ask a guard to open the door or just knock.
- Your mgpvolunteers.org website sign-on is no longer available. You are welcome to use another docent's sign-on with his/her permission.
- You are removed from the active docent email group. We then add your address to the honorary docent email group.

These changes are in accordance with museum security policies.

Each fall, at the annual docent luncheon, we will recognize and celebrate those who went honorary within the previous touring year.
